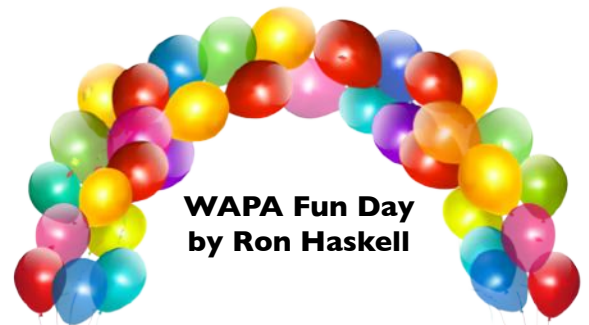

All WAPA participants will be given priority move-in, so you can unload your antique machinery. Unload quickly and then park your vehicle in either the **TRAILER PARKING LOT** on the Northwest corner of Third & B Streets, or the parking lot at C Street and Bonita.

- **VERY IMPORTANT:** The Fire Dept. is requesting that **ALL VENDORS HAVE A FIRE EXTINGUISHER** in your booth.
- **EZ Up canopies** must be weighted down and secured properly so they won't blow around.
- **TRAILERS, VANS & TRUCKS** – Parking is **VERY LIMITED** in the surrounding areas of the Car Show, and we need every parking space possible. Please Park your vehicle in the **TRAILER PARKING LOT at the north west corner of Third & B Streets; or the parking lot at C Street and Bonita**
