It is time again for the Marina del Rey Show. On the fourth Sunday of July, WAPA supports the Classic Yacht Association's Old Fashioned Day in the Park at Marina del Rey by bringing our engines and joining various car clubs. The show is held at Burton Chace Park, right at the docks. Our show area is next to the Fish Cleaning Station as we were in 2019. Note the later arrival time so that we do not block the road for the show cars.

Here are the particulars:

What: Classic Yacht Association's 44th Annual Old Fashioned Day in the Park

Where: Burton Chace Park, Marina del Rey

When: Sunday, July 24th, 2022

Time: Set-up begins at 8:30 am, The show starts around 10 am and ends at 3 pm. If you get there early, wait on the street until 8:30 am so all the show cars can enter and get past our show area. Unload and then park as directed below.

Parking: There will be limited parking inside the park. No trailers due to limited space. Parking will be two wide at the road turn around on the north side. As you come in note the area on your right as you transition to the paved road. Do not block the road when parking.

Directions: Burton Chace Park is at the end on Mindanao Way just west of Lincoln Blvd. in Marina del Rey. One way there is to go west on the Marina Freeway, Cal 90, from the 405 Freeway and turn left on Mindanao Way. Go to the end and at the turn around there is a gate and there will be someone there to let you in. Follow the grass covered road through the park to the paved section. Continue on and on your right will be some tables and then the fish cleaning station. This is where we set-up. Bring your own supplies.

I will not be able to attend but the contact for show area is Joel Feldman with the cars and the contact for the Yachts is Rick Olson.
